



**Gracepath: Biblical Womanhood
Fall 2011/Spring 2012
Homework Assignment #1**

In anticipation of our next meeting, we've prepared four daily assignments. Each day, you'll read a short portion of the Bible and answer two or three questions. Since time spent in God's word is best when it is conversational (God speaks to you, you respond) we've included a prayer prompt as well.

Day #1

Read Genesis 2:16-17 and 3:1.

How did the serpent (Satan) confuse the woman?

How does Satan try to confuse people today?

How might Satan mix truth and lies in your mind?

Ask God to show you areas where you are confused.

Day #2

Read 2 Corinthians 11:14 and John 8:44.

List 3 characteristics of Satan from these verses.

Read Genesis 3:2-4.

How did the serpent lie to the woman?

How has Satan lied to you regarding your femininity?

Ask God to show you areas where you have been deceived.

Day #3

Read James 1:13-15.

What causes temptation?

Read Genesis 3:5-6.

List some ways the woman was tempted.

What is tempting about being “like God”? How could the desire to “like God” be harmful in a marriage or other close relationship?

Ask God to show you areas where you are vulnerable to temptation.

Day #4

Read Genesis 3:7-8.

What was the immediate impact of their sin for the man and the woman on their relationship with each other?

What was the impact on their relationship with God?

Are you hiding anything from God?

Ask God to show you areas of your life that you are trying to “hide” from Him.
