Homework Assignment #2**

In anticipation of our next meeting, we've prepared four daily assignments. Each day, you'll read a short portion of the Bible and answer two or three questions. Since time spent in God's word is best when it is conversational (God speaks to you, you respond) we've included a prayer prompt as well.

***Day #1***

Read Isaiah 43:7

According to this passage, why did God create people?

What do you think it means to bring glory to God?

How might you personally accomplish that?

Ask God to show you ways that you can bring him glory this week.

**Day #2**

Read Genesis 1:26-28

According to verses 26 & 27, what pattern did God use when he made man?

According to verse 28, "man" includes whom?

What do you think it means that male and female, **together**, are created in the image of God?

Based on this passage, what do you think is the significance of **being a woman**?

Thank God for making you as He did, in His image and for His glory.

**Day #3**

Read Genesis 1:26-28

According to verse 26, why did God create man? What is our job?

What do you think that job entails?

How can you personally help accomplish that job?

Ask God to help you see your piece in the important job of ruling nature for Him.

**Day #4**

Read Genesis 2:18-22

Why was the woman created?

Read Genesis 49:29, Psalm 46:1, and Psalm 54:4  
Who is described as a helper in these passages?

Is “helper” a positive or negative term in these passages?

In what ways might it be a positive thing for woman to be the helper of man?

Thank God for the lofty assignment of being a helper, like Him. Ask Him to show you ways that you can be more like Him in this area.
